WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen do further find, determine and adjudge that no sation for abandoning the said undeveloped right of way at Parkway Lane is due to the owners of compe

the real property abutting thereon, they have petitioned for and consented to abandoning the said right of way of that portion of Parkway Lane and have waived any and all claims for compensation, Said property shall be deeded to the Woodmont Company, LLC, 2100 W.,  $7^{\circ}$  Street, Fort Worth, TX 76109, Woodmont Company, LLC, shall issue an easement for the right of way to the City of Petal for
