#### CITY OF PETAL **ORDINANCE BOOK 4**

#### ORDINANCE NUMBER 1979 (42-A438)

# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF ORDINANCE 1972(42) OF THE COMPRENSIVE ZONING REGULATIONS FOR THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI, AMENDING ARTICLE XI. PLANNING COMMISSION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY

OF PETAL. MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION 1: The following article of Ordinance 1979 (42) be amended as follows:

#### ARTICLE XI. PLANNING COMMISSION

- 11.0 Establishment and Organization of Planning Commission

   A Planning Commission is hereby established (Mississippi Code 1972. § 17-1-11).
   The Planning Commission shall consist of eight members, all of whom must be citizen members representing their respective wards, with the exception of the al-large positions whom must be citizen members residing in any ward within the city limits.

  Planning Commission members shall serve with pay at the rate of \$100,00 per meeting attended monthly, including all scheduled and special meetings, not to exceed \$200,00 per month.
  - per month.

SECTION 2. Except as hereby expressly changed and amended, the aforesaid Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance No. 1979 (42) of the City of Petal, Mississippi, shall be and remain in full force.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force within thirty (30) days from and after its passage as provided by law. The foregoing Ordinance having been reduced to writing, the same was introduced and read, and a vote was taken thereon. first section by section and then upon the Ordinance as a whole with the following results:
